## Who can apply?

You can apply for this role if you:



- Are 18 years or older



- Have an intellectual disability



- Can join online meetings



- Are interested in making information easier to understand for people with intellectual disability



- Can work an extra 3 hours per week

## How much will I be paid?



DSA will pay you as a **casual worker**.

This means you get paid for the time you work.

Applications can be:


