

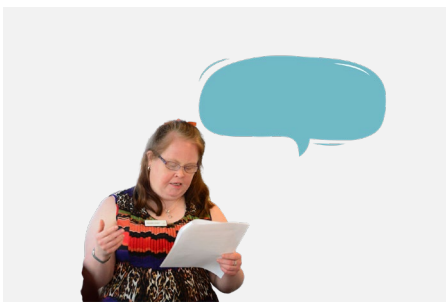

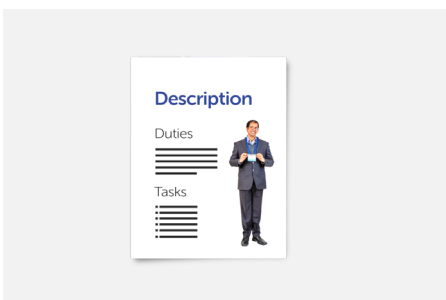

This sheet is for people who want to be a **Board member** for Down Syndrome Australia (DSA).



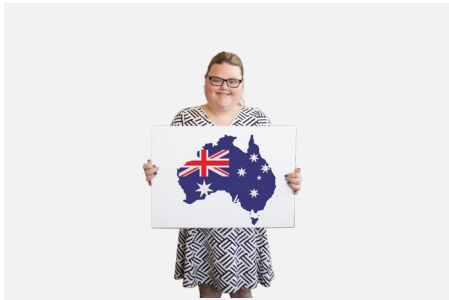
A Board member is someone who helps to guide DSA's work.

DSA is the national organisation for people with Down syndrome and their families.



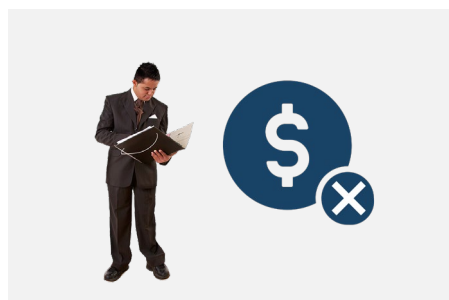
We work to support people with Down syndrome, their families, and the community.



Our Board helps guide the work we do. It makes sure we are strong, safe, and effective.

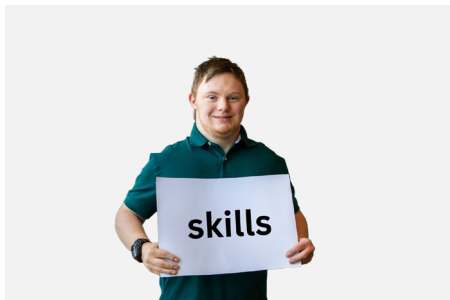


We are looking for a new volunteer Board member.



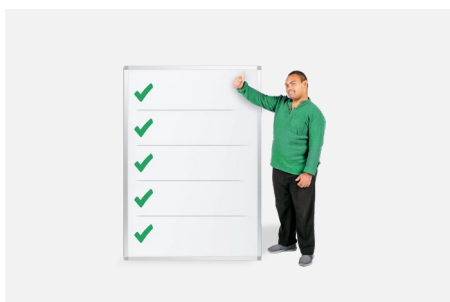
Volunteer means this is not a paid position.

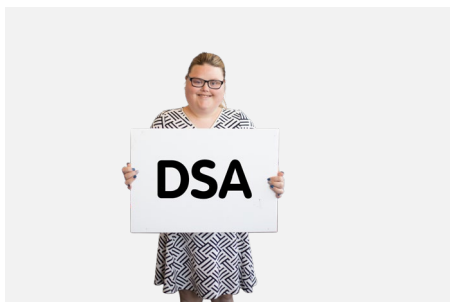

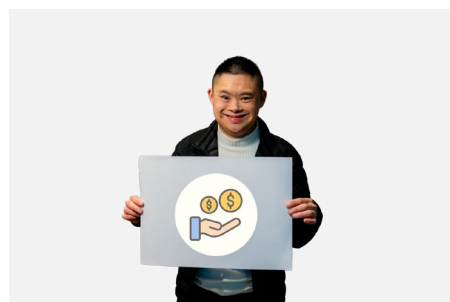
Your skills are in 1 or more of these areas:

- **Marketing:** helping us reach more people and share our message



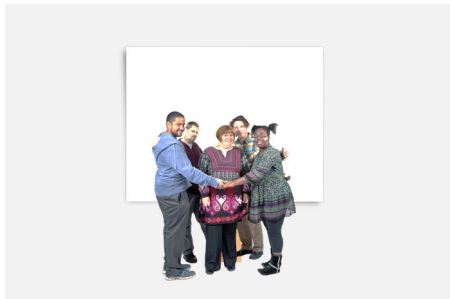
- **Fundraising:** helping us raise money to support our work



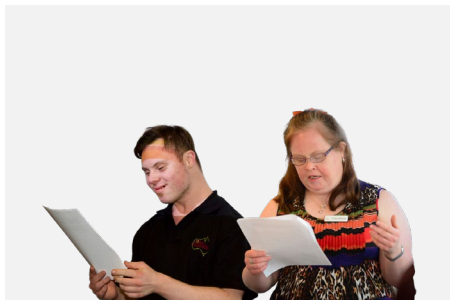
- **Information Technology (IT):** helping us use technology in the best way

- Can work well with others as part of a team

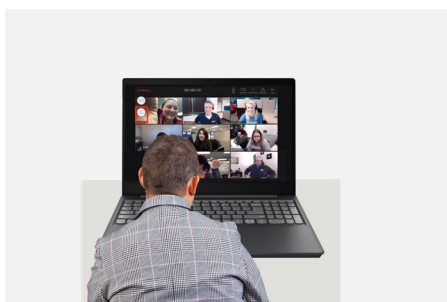


- Are willing to give their time, ideas, and energy to help our organisation grow

Board members attend regular Board meetings.



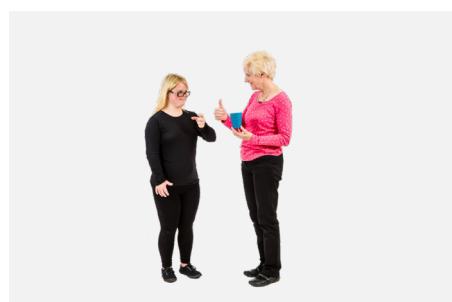
There are 4 meetings a year.

They take part in discussions to make decisions.

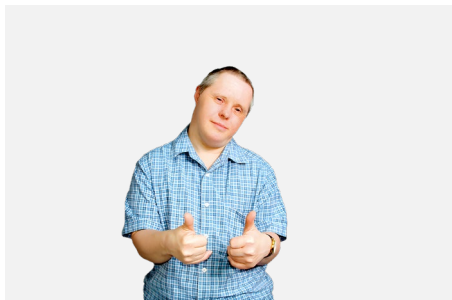


The time commitment is around 6 to 8 hours a month.

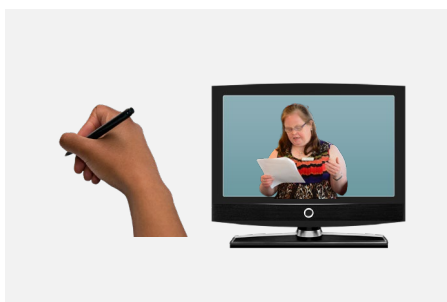


DSA provides support to take part for Board members with Down syndrome or intellectual disability.

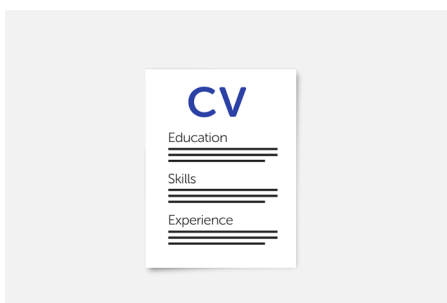
