

General UP!Club rules:

Everyone should expect to have a great time at UP!Club, in a safe environment. To ensure this happens, it is important that all participants act in a responsible and mature way.

Acting in a responsible and mature way means you should:

Treat everyone with respect and use good manners.

Listen to the Group Coordinator and Volunteers when they are talking to you and follow any instructions.

Talk to the Group Coordinator or Volunteers if something is upsetting you.

Respect other people's personal space.

Act in a socially acceptable manner by displaying modesty, dignity and respectability in your actions.

Stay with the group at all times.

Ask for help if you need it.

Try to have fun at all times!

What might happen if someone is not acting in a responsible and mature way?

This might upset other people. It may even put people's safety at risk.

When someone's behavior is upsetting the group they may be asked to have a discussion about this before participating in further activities.
