Specialist Disability Accommodation is

housing for people who have an extreme functional impairment or very high support needs.





Building Types











House (2 or 3 residents)

Villa/Duplex/Townhouse (maximum 3 residents)

Apartment (maximum 2 residents) **Group home** (4 to 5 residents)

Improved Liveability



Is for people with a sensory, intellectual or cognitive impairment.



'The designed environment responds to the needs of participants through improved physical access and enhanced provision for participants with sensory, intellectual or cognitive impairment. For example Improved Liveability dwellings should include one or more additional design features such as luminance contrasts, improved wayfinding and/or lines of sight depending on the needs of the participants' -NDIS SDA Design Category Requirements Guidelines
