Dear SA community members.

My apologies for not getting this out to more promptly after my visit to SA in August. During the visit, I was able to visit a number of hospitals, and also meet with 27 families over the 4 days. I met with a number of stakeholders and contacted several more. Thank you to everyone for your warmth and kindness. I enjoyed meeting you all, attending the Parent presentation at Flinders medical was an absolute highlight. The parent group were incredible sharing their stories with over 150 medical students.

During the visit a number of key things were discussed including

- The possibility of a new community based organisation to support the SA Down syndrome community.
- Some additional age specific Facebook groups to support specific groups such as Primary and Secondary school aged children. These are coming!
- We also discussed the need to have a person on the ground in SA. We absolutely agree and you will find the job ad for the role below.

Over the last 3 months we have responded to 12 family specific emails and a number of phone calls from the community.

In an important step forward, we have included a link to a survey open to people with Down syndrome and their families / carers. The survey seeks to collate data on the interest for a new community based association in South Australia that would provide a platform to increase services and connections within the Down syndrome community.
