What is the job?

As a member of DSAN you will:



- Attend monthly meetings online or in person
- Speak up and support people with Down syndrome
- Join in events and activities as a DSV staff member



This is a paid position.

It is a **casual job** and you will be paid for the hours you work.



The in person or online meeting is once a month on Friday.



There will be the chance to work on more projects.

We will ask you if you would like to work on the project.

We will let you know, when, where and for how long.
