
Providing FEEDBACK about your hospital experience



DO YOU KNOW: You can share feedback on your hospital experience?

- We all want to have a good hospital experience when we or our family member/s are unwell.
- When we can share our experiences openly and helpfully, the hospital and health system can make improvements, so all people can benefit.
- There are a few ways in which you can share your story:
 - Using an independent group called Care Opinion; or
 - Contacting the **specific hospital** or service directly.






What is Care Opinion?

<u>CARE OPINION</u> is independent site where anyone can share their stories (both good and bad) about their experience of care.

- Care Opinion covers health and aged care, and community services in Australia.
- Care Opinion is a place where you can:
 - Share your stories about care and support services you have used.
 - See what others are saying about services.
 - See how services respond and whether they make an improvement.

Why share your experience on Care Opinion?

- It gives you a public voice to share your experience of services.
- Ensure that the right people will hear your story.
- Sharing your stories can help make services better.
- It is safe, confidential and independent of services and authorities.



Direct feedback to hospitals and services

You can also provide feedback via patient or consumer contact points located at every health service/ hospital.

- A patient or consumer contact person is usually known as a liaison officer. There may have different names for these roles in different hospitals.
