

Home visiting services. Perth Children's Hospital (PCH)



Do you know PCH has Home Visiting Services?



- Perth Children's Hospital has two home visiting services.
- Hospital in the Home (HITH) and Post-Acute Care (PAC) services are available for children to receive treatment and care in their home as an alternative to staying in or returning to hospital.
- Hospital in the Home provides acute care for **medically stable** children who require regular health services, and who would otherwise be in hospital.
- Post-Acute Care service provides **acute and chronic care** for children at their home following discharge from hospital.
- HITH & PAC nurses work as a team to carry out intravenous antibiotics, dressings, clinical assessments, central venous access devices (CVAD) care and provide support to parents.





Services are available from 7am – 10pm every day of the week.
